PFLA Board Highlights

November 12, 2022 Meeting

The Board met on Saturday Nov 12 - here are some of the key points;

1. There are currently members who are out of compliance regarding the rules on storing trailers on PFLA property. Members cannot store trailers at PF without prior board notification and permission. The board discussed not wanting these issues to fall solely on the President to enforce. The Document task force will prioritize the rules and member fines, work that is already on their work plan. In the meantime, the trailers being stored at PF by members need to be removed.
2. Hospitality committee is planning a holiday-themed retirement party to celebrate and thank Andy and Chris for their service to PF. It is December 10 at 6 pm. Please RSVP to Beth. Place is dependent on the number of attendees (tea room or social hall).

3. The annual Hunter Safety meeting will be held on Friday 11/25/2022 at 7 pm in the tea room. This is mandatory for all planning on hunting at PFLA. Rob Gally will host.

4. Property committee reported that a new security fence is currently being installed at the tennis courts. Also, the tennis courts and shuffleboard sports courts will be completely resurfaced in the Spring 2023 due to material issues (covered by the warranty). The committee is also planning on building a rock wall behind the dumpster and are gathering rocks to use. Let Rob Gally know if you have large rocks (1-2 feet in length) that the Association can use.

5. Finance committee conducted their annual internal audit of the records, expenses and insurance. They are also looking into a few ideas for keeping an open line of credit for the Association to be used for emergencies and for options for the best ways to allocate budget surpluses at the end of the year. Research is ongoing.

6. Long Range planning is looking for a full-time PFLA resident to join the committee. Contact Shannon Barr if interested.
