GRAMER RENTAL CONTINUED

After the Mary J. Drexel home ceased using it as a retreat, the ownership of Abend Ruhe passed to P.F.L.A. which used it in several ways including its rental to Clyde Cramer and family. They used it as a year round residence and as a small office for Clyde's construction company from 1947 to 1953.

As seen below, it was then a white residence with green shutters. The basement remains dirt and rough-hewn logs support the structure. A separate pump house pumped well water to it, the Deaconess Cottage and a home not on P.F.L.A. land.

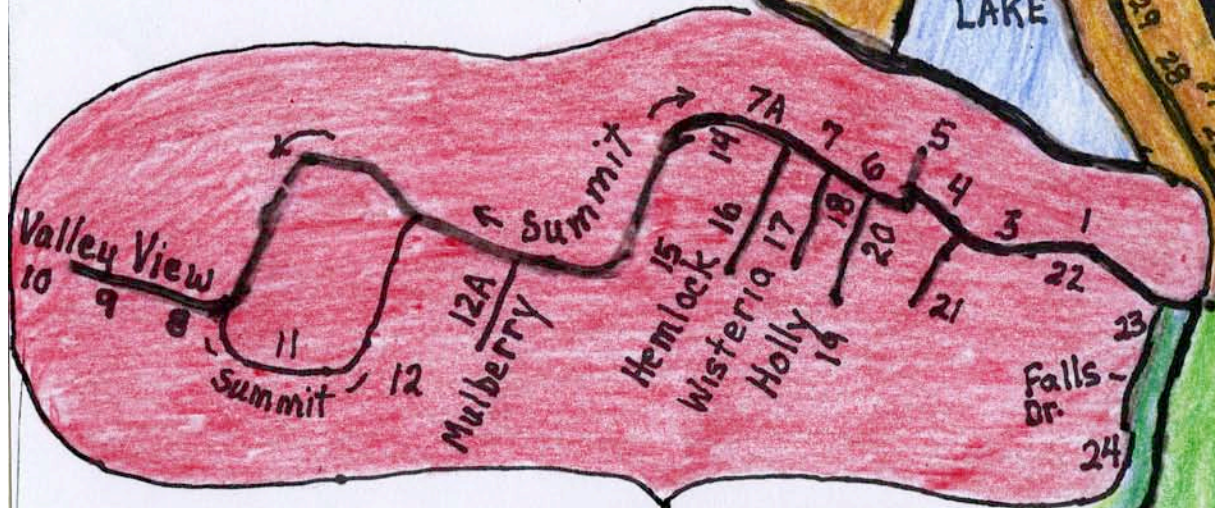

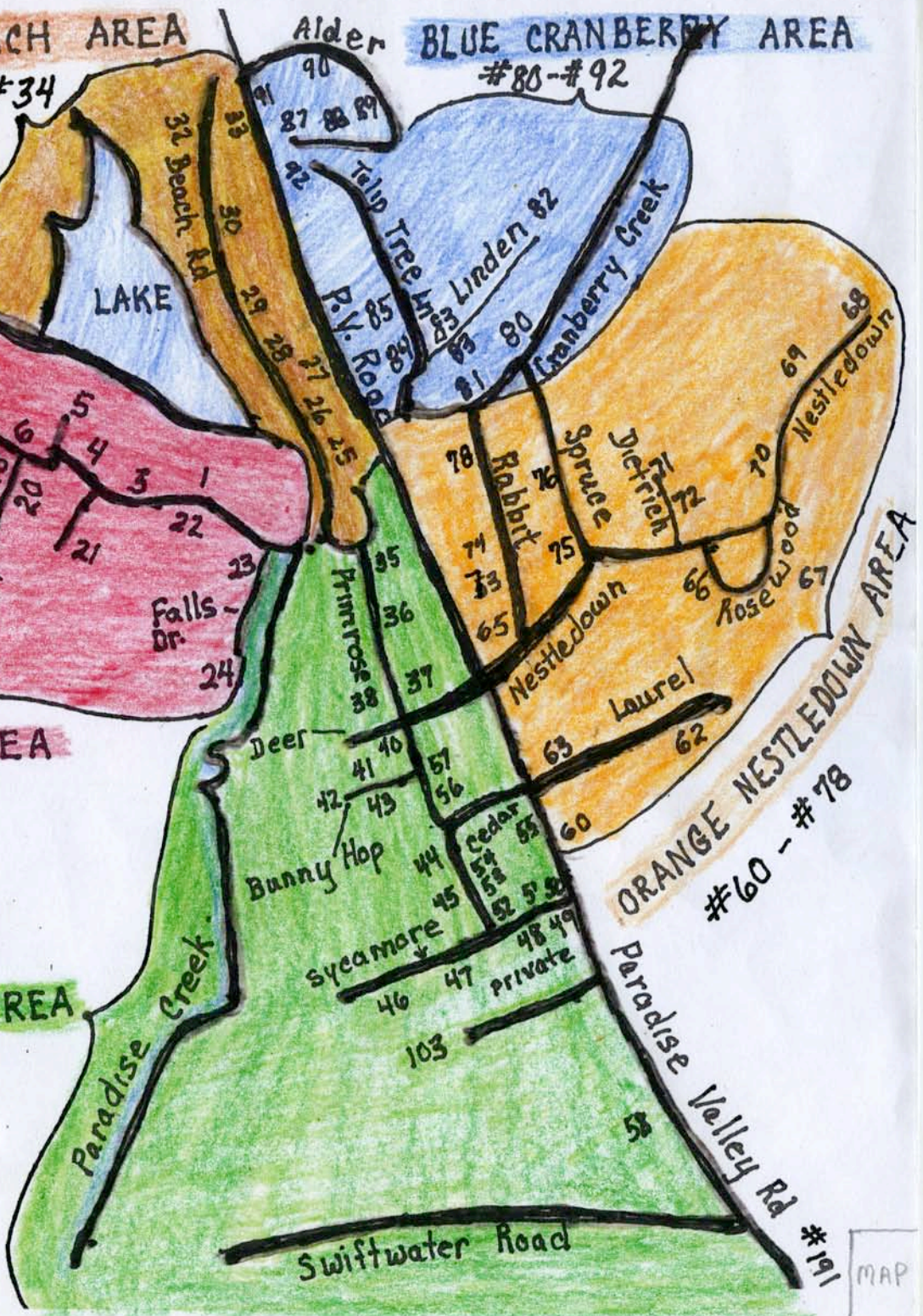
