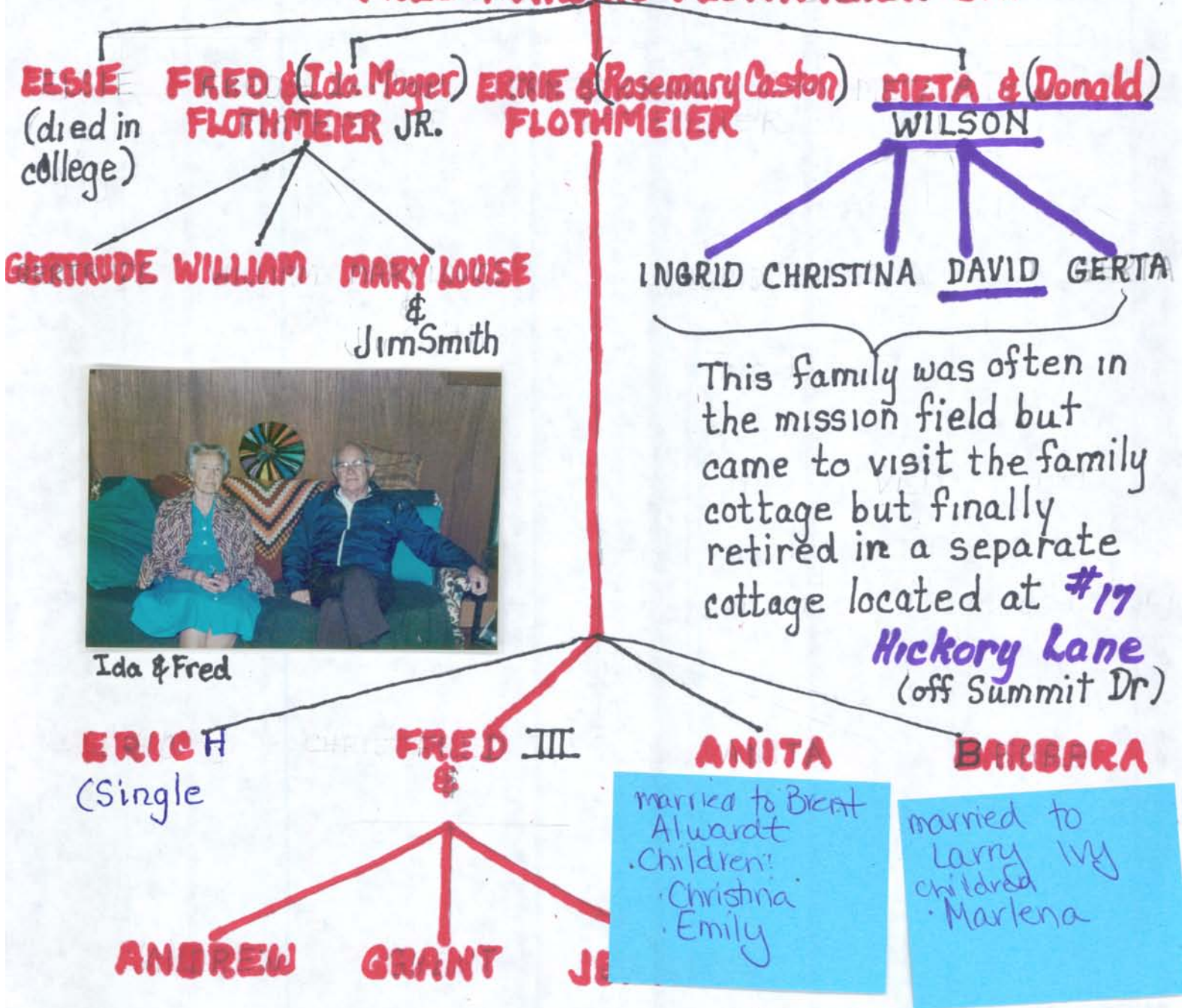

Spray Article

The Angermann Family owned the #12A Cottage (now Higgins) on Summit Hill in the late 1940s & 50's. The common sisters and their contemporaries might remember Bill, a PF lifeguard and his younger sister Elfriede from that era. See Red Cottage Book in #12A section for a family write up and photos.

After Bill's recent death, his widow found a 1945 photo of young Bill and a very big trout caught in Lake Crawford. Upon seeing that photo, sister Elfriede "penned for Bill" the sentiments she was sure he felt about the photo and his happy days at P.F.

We print here the photo and "Bill's Farewell" in memory of old friends (living and deceased) and the enduring charms of our beloved P.F.

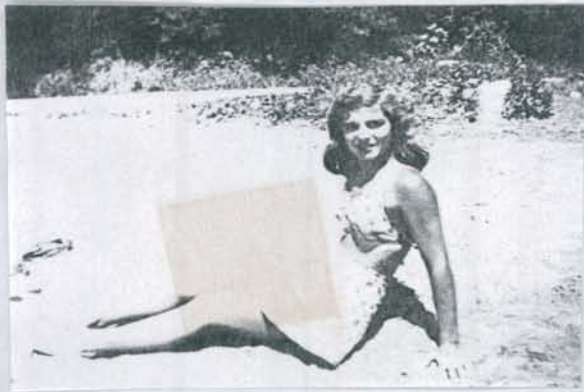
